

TECHNICAL RULES

Preamble:

On the 5th and 6th of August 2023, the second edition of the 12-hour memorial race "Giovanni Coroni" will take place.

It's a team race which will take place on the permanent Mini Racing Chiasso race track, with the following rules;

Participants and entry fees:

- Only the **first 11 teams** that will return the official registration form will be admitted (no other methods of registration are allowed). In order for the registration to be complete, Mini Racing Chiasso must also receive the payment for the registration fees (the order of receipt of payment will be the tie-breaking rule for admission);
- A team must be composed of **at least 2 drivers** (without a limit on the amount of drivers per team), hence any registration received for teams with only one driver will not be taken into consideration;
- Only one driver at a time for each team is allowed on the drivers' stand;
- The registration fee for each team is CHF/EUR 80.00 and must be transferred to the organizing committee by following the instructions the team captain will receive after filling in and submitting the registration form;

Allowed models:

- Forward Wheel Drive - MST TCR
- Forward Wheel Drive - FWD

There will be separate standings for the two categories

Each team is allowed to have **two models of the same category**, in order to allow for better driver management - some pilots might be using a steering wheel controller, while some others might prefer a stick radio.

Allowed Tyres:

- For the MST TCR category: SP RACING SPEL036/R
- For the FWD Category: P-ONE ASPHALT

There is no quantity limit for the tires!

Allowed car bodies:

The rules are the same as for the "Campionato Sociale" from Mini Racing Chiasso. The only difference is that GT Bodies are allowed.

If a team decides to use two models, they will either have to use the same body, or they will have two bodies with the same exact colors and graphics.

Lighting system:

Every team must have a lighting system, which will need to be turned on during the timeframe that will be communicated by the race director.

The lighting system must follow these minimum requirements:

- 2 white LEDs for the front lights;
- 2 red LEDs for the rear lights;

The lighting system can either be powered by the car battery (the same battery used to power the motor) or with an external source (for example, an auxiliary battery).

Execution:

- The starting order will be decided by raffle. No qualifiers will be performed.
- The race will start **at 21:00 on Saturday 5th of August** and will end **at 9:00 on Sunday 6th of August**;
- At the end of the event, around 9:30/9:45, a breakfast will be offered to all the participants, in order to celebrate this experience together.

The rules could be subject to modification.
